WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of April 7, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution No.2015-33 authorizing advertising and calling for bids for the Marina Equestrian Center Tree Trimming Project, and;

WHEREAS, the bid was from EL Gabilan Tree Service of Salinas, California, in the amount of \$20,475.00, and;

WHEREAS, after reviewing the bid, it was determined that the bid from EL Gabilan Tree Service of Salinas, California, in the amount of \$20,475.00 was from a un-responsive bidder who was not registered with the DIR as required for bidding public projects, and;

WHEREAS, if approved, the project will be re-bid for trimming and pruning of trees at the Marina Equestrian Center.

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal impact when rejecting bids or calling for bids.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Marina does hereby:

1. Authorize the rejection of EL Gabilan Tree Service bid, and;
2. Authorize advertising and call for bids to trim and prune trees located at the Marina Equestrian Center with a reduced scope of work.

REQUEST:

It is requested that the City Council consider:

BACKGROUND:

ANALYSIS:

On May 7, 2015, one (1) sealed bid was received, opened and publicly read for the project. The bid from EL Gabilan Tree Service of Salinas, California, in the amount of \$20,475.00 was determined to be from a un-responsive bidder who was not registered with the DIR as required for bidding public projects.

If approved, the project will be re-bid for trimming and pruning of trees at the Marina Equestrian Center.
